Our work goes beyond the products we produce, and stretches from how we design them, carefully choose the materials, work with our suppliers, transport the products and engage our customers into consuming them in a sustainable way.



We only use organic cotton which is grown without harmful chemical pesticides and artificial fertilizers. The cotton is harvested on a small scale by farmers in Adilabad, India, ensured of a decent salary and working conditions.



Our recycled polyester comes both from post-consumer waste of PET-bottles and chemically recycled textiles, also collected from consumer waste. This process means the fabric gives a new lease of life to waste material that is not naturally biodegradable.



All leather we use has been tanned in tanneries that conforms to our highly set standards regarding social and environmental conditions, which has been third-party verified by the Leather Working Group.



Our recycled nylon is made from post-industrial waste, derived from discarded nylon-based products. Reclaimed nylon waste, which otherwise would be incinerated, are shredded and turned into a new, lightweight and durable fabric.



Steering clear of harmful chemicals means that we keep those chemicals out of local water supplies. By restricting harmful chemicals and placing higher requirements than the legislation, we also contribute to a healthy work environment for the people producing our bags.



At Sandqvist we strive to re-use waste materials in all of our products, and extend the life of our bags through our in-store repair service and care products.



All of our bags are designed to last for a long time. We hold our fabrics and trims to high quality standards, making sure that durability and resistance is a corner stone of our product development.



We take great pride in maintaining a kind supply chain, with fair wages and safe work environments for everyone involved from sketch to finished bag.

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
